



Introduction to Winemaking classes



- We run introduction to winemaking classes each year in October at B'darra Estate Winery, 1415 Stumpy Gully Road, Moorooduc
- Classes are held from 9am-Noon, on two Saturdays in October
- The course fee of \$150 includes a starter pack, which contains a winemaking book, equipment and materials to make your first batch of raspberry wine
- During the course speakers will cover a variety of topics including winemaking techniques, wine appreciation and different styles of wine.
- At the end of the course, you will have your first 5 litres of fruit wine, well on the way to completion
- The techniques taught can be applied to grape winemaking and guild members can 'mentor' you through the grape winemaking process
